People: Peace in heaven and glory in the highest.

Celebrant: Let us pray.

Assist us mercifully with your help, O Lord God of our salvation, that we may enter with joy upon the contemplation of those mighty acts, whereby you have given us life and immortality; through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Mark 11:1-11a

Priest: The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ,  
According to Mark.

People: Glory to you, Lord Christ.

Priest: The Gospel of the Lord.

People: Praise to you, Lord Christ.

## Blessing of the Palms

BCP, p. 271

Priest: The Lord be with you.

People: And also with you.

Priest: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: It is right to give him thanks and praise.

*(The Priest blesses the palms for distribution to the people.)*

Celebrant: Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.  
 People: Hosanna in the highest.

*(The palms are distributed to the people.)*

Celebrant: Let us go forth in peace.  
 People: In the name of Christ, Amen.


